Introduction:

The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) was passed into law in 2003 by President George W. Bush. The act mandated zero tolerance of sexual abuse inside correctional facilities and developed standards to detect and prevent sexual abuse and sexual harassment of those incarcerated. This report has been compiled in compliance with those standards.

PREA Incident Types by allegation:

Substantiated: Investigated and determined to have occurred.

Unsubstantiated: Investigated, however not enough evidence to determine an incident had occurred.

Unfounded: An allegation that was investigated and determined to not have occurred.

Ongoing: Investigation has not been completed.

Investigations:

Every allegation made is investigated. If an allegation of sexual abuse is substantiated, the perpetrator will be charged with a criminal act and JCPD will work closely with prosecutors to ensure prosecution. Any reports made in bad faith will also be referred to prosecutors, and criminal and/or disciplinary charges will be pursued.

Facilities included in data collection:

Johnson City Detention Facility

Inmates and incidents included in data collection:

Inmates housed in the Johnson City Detention Facility between January 1st 2016 and December 31, 2016.

Any incident of sexual misconduct, sexual harassment, or sexual abuse involving inmate-on-inmate or staff-on-inmate.
