The Johnson City Board of Commissioners is requesting letters of interest from individuals interested in filling the remaining two-year term of Commissioner Ralph Van Brocklin. The appointment will serve through November 2020. City commissioners are required to be eligible voters and current city residents.

Letters of interest should include, at a minimum, a short discussion of why you are interested in being appointed, the qualifications that you bring to this position, your specific experience and participation in civic and public service, and your vision for the future of Johnson City. Letters are due by Monday, October 1 at 5 p.m. The City Commission may hold interviews with a select number of applicants on Monday, October 15. Applicants will be contacted if they are selected for an interview. The Commission will make the appointment at the Thursday, October 18 City Commission meeting.
